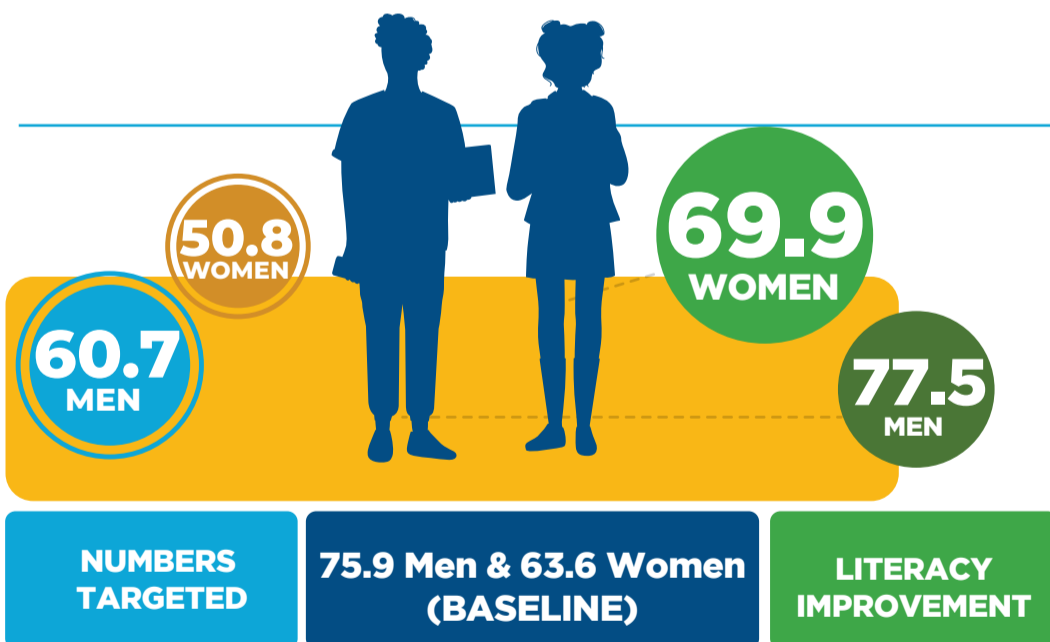
Children under five years of age who are developmentally on track in health, learning and psychosocial well-being



Gross enrolment ratio in secondary education

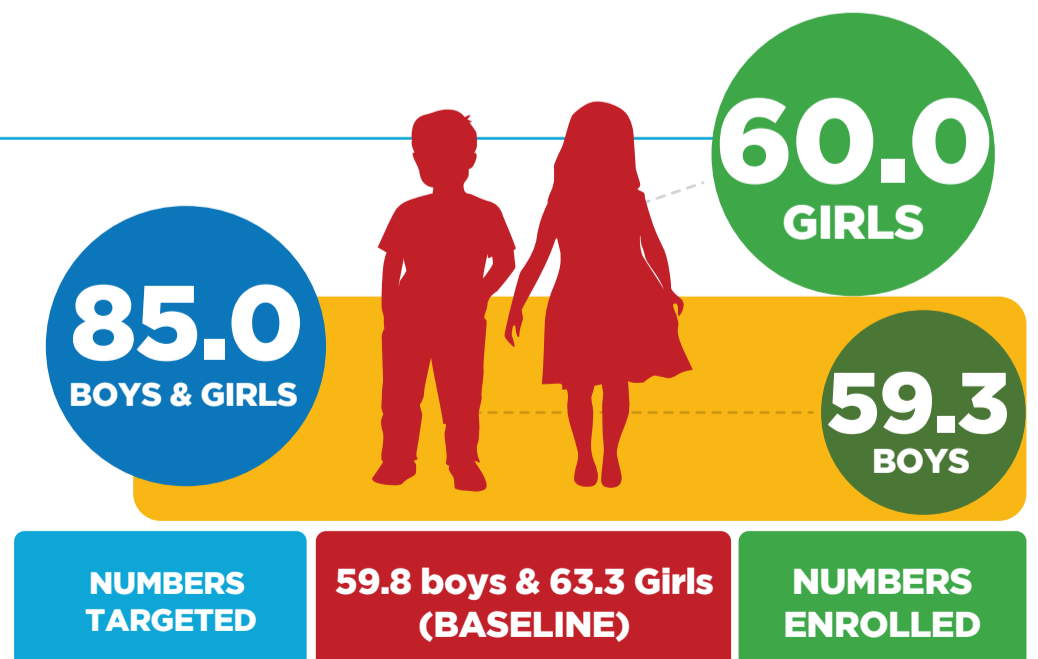


Average years of schooling of the population aged 25 years and older by sex

Primary (P7) completion rate by sex



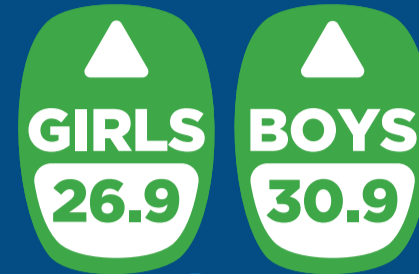

Prevalence of stunting among Children under five years

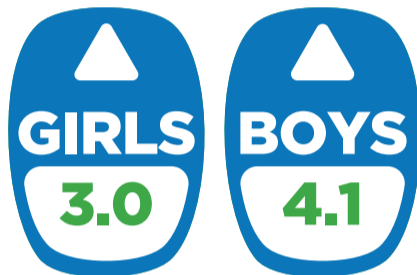

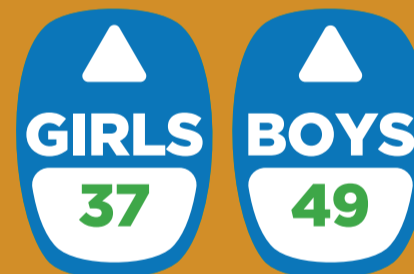


Infant mortality rate (per 1,000 live births)

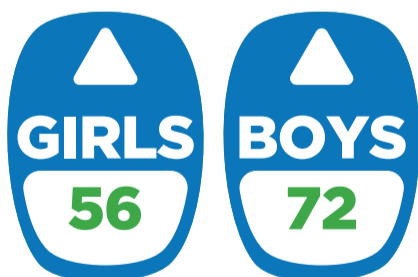

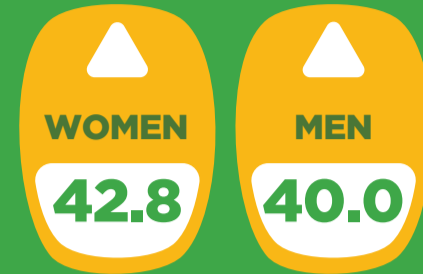

Proportion of the employed population in the agriculture sector

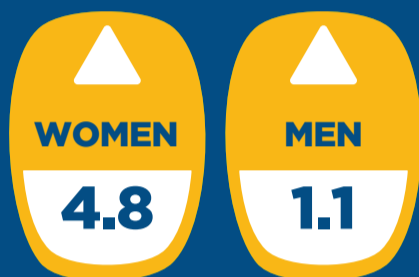
